**Amazon** is the most successful retail company in the world, pulling in huge profits year after year. As they continue to expand their business, they are controlling more and more of downtown Seattle's real estate.

With all this development, Amazon needs to hold their contract companies, such as **Security Industry Specialists (SIS)**, accountable for their actions in the Seattle community. Right now more than 800 nonunion security officers—who protect the people and property at Amazon—are directly employed by SIS.

In 2015, SIS settled charges for violating the city's paid sick time law and settled charges with the federal government for violating workers' rights to form a union right; all right here at Amazon headquarters.

This isn't right.

SIS officers have continually reached out to Security Industry Specialists management and to Amazon about their working conditions: stagnant wages, favoritism and perceived unfair treatment around race and religion. Community supporters, interfaith groups and tech workers have joined and were met with silence.

It's time to tell SIS and Amazon that we need Good Jobs for Service Workers in Tech.
